



Where Can I Find Help?

Do you have lots of questions? Do you need more information? There is a lot to think about when leaving school. Here are some of the issues your VR transition counselor or its partner agencies help with:

- Transportation, including driver training, adaptive equipment for driving, etc.
- Counseling about the effect of work on your Social Security benefits
- Legal issues, such as guardianship, Americans with Disabilities Act, and other legal information
- Special equipment (assistive technology) that might help you to live independently
- Additional education after high school such as college, training and apprenticeships, and other programs
- How to find housing
- Medical benefits
- Attendant care services
- Supported employment
- Services through the Vermont Department of Labor
- Other issues that may be of concern to you

Your VR transition counselor helps you and your family find the resources, information, and support you need to make decisions and plan for your future.
